## Alternative Summer School Program

Richard McKenna Charter High School provides an online Alternative Summer School program for at-risk students in Idaho.

Students who enroll in our online Alternative Summer School program must have completed the 8th grade, be younger than 21 years old, and qualify as an at-risk student as defined by Idaho State Code.

Students are considered at-risk if they meet at least three of qualifiers 1-6, and/or one of qualifiers 7-12 listed below:

1. Has repeated at least one (1) grade.
2. Has absenteeism that is greater than ten percent (10%) during the preceding semester.
3. Has an overall grade point average that is less than 1.5 (4.0 scale) prior to enrolling in an alternative secondary program.
4. Has failed one (1) or more academic subjects.
5. Is two (2) or more semester credits per year behind the rate required to graduate.
6. Is a limited English proficient student who has not been in a program more than three (3) years.
7. Has substance abuse behavior.
8. Is pregnant or a parent.
9. Is an emancipated youth.(Is living on his/her own and providing for his/her livelihood.)
10. Is a previous drop out.
11. Has serious personal, emotional, or medical problems.
12. Is a court or agency referral.

### **ENROLL NOW**

- Registration begins **April 16th**, and ends **May 30th**, 4:00 PM, MDT.
- Courses begin **June 4th**, and end **August 3rd**, 11:59 PM, MDT.
- Students may enroll in up to three courses. All courses are Self-paced--students may work as fast as they want, but not as slow as they want.
- There are no extensions for Alternative Summer School courses.
